Come to our June Social/Study Club!! We will be meeting at Times Square Restaurant at 718 E. Union Hills Drive in Phoenix on Tuesday evening, June 5, from 6-8 p.m. (Social is from 6-7 p.m. and Study Club is from 7-8 p.m.). The title of this month's Study Club is: "Chemotherapy and Oral Sores."

The speaker is James L. Ratcliff is Chairman of the Board and CEO of Rowpar Pharmaceuticals, Inc., maker of the Dentists Choice and ClōSYS brands of oral care products. Dr. Ratcliff has served as senior research scientist, professor and director, Center for the Study of Higher Education at the Pennsylvania State University. He is author of 120 articles, books, book chapters, is co-inventor on over 24 patents and patents pending. He is an active member of the Arizona Biotechnology Assn., American Academy of Oral and Systemic Health, American Education Research Assn., and the International Association for Dental Research. He holds a Ph.D. in Higher Education, and a M.A. in History.

Dr. Ratcliff will be discussing how mouth sores, mouth ulcers, or oral mucositis (OM) are abrasions of the mucosal layer of the oral cavity. OM is an important issue for cancer patients since most patients undergoing chemotherapy or radiation therapy face a risk of developing OM. In some patients these ulcers become so severe that they have to delay or discontinue the cancer treatment.

Dr. Ratcliff will further discuss how often medical professionals circumvent OM by maintaining good oral health e.g. by regular use of oral rinse.
