

## Nomination Guidelines for Elected Positions

Elections take place at the annual General Assembly each year. Any member may declare their candidacy for an elected position in advance by notifying Jeanette Lalli by email, [jlalli.azdha@gmail.com](mailto:jlalli.azdha@gmail.com), OR can be nominated during the General Assembly. Self-nominations are welcome!

**Qualifications** Anyone who has been a voting member of AzDHA for at least one year is eligible to run for any of the elected positions described below.

Available positions are as follows:

### Board of Directors

- Four (4) directors to serve two (2) year terms – term begins in January
- Meeting commitment:

The board holds a full-day in-person orientation meeting followed by monthly meetings either by conference call or in person. In addition, the board holds a 1.5-day strategic planning meeting. Additional meetings are held as needed.

- Officers

Once the elections are finalized at the General Assembly, there will be a subsequent meeting of the Board of Directors to determine the officers: president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer.

### ADHA Delegates and Alternates

- Two (2) delegates to serve two (2) year terms – term begins after General Assembly
- Up to four (4) alternate delegates to serve one (1) year terms – term begins after General Assembly
- Under meeting commitment, Please change:
- Meeting commitment: Attendance at district workshops and all relevant business meetings during the ADHA Annual Meeting/House of Delegates is required. The ADHA 2023 Business Meeting will be posted on the ADHA.org website as they are available.
- Available Funding: AzDHA budgets funds annually to help defray costs related to travel, housing, and meals. This year, we are able to assist all delegates and the 1st alternate.
